- Hold a valid Ontario 307A Steamfitter (Construction) Certificate of Qualification, and
- Successfully complete the UA “Work Ready” training program prior to joining the job site.

Key Responsibilities

- Install, fit, and assemble carbon and stainless steel process piping systems (flanged, welded, threaded, and grooved).
- Read and interpret P&IDs, isometric drawings, and blueprints to execute precise layout and installation.
- Measure, cut, thread, and bend piping to required specifications using appropriate tools and methods.
- Install valves, fittings, and supports according to drawings and project requirements.
- Perform hydrostatic and pneumatic testing, flushing, and system turnovers in compliance with project standards.

- Work safely in industrial environments, adhering to all Procon and site-specific procedures (permits, confined space, working at heights, LOTO).
- Collaborate with foremen, welders, and project supervisors to complete installations efficiently and safely.
